

APPLICATION FOR AUTHORITY
OF
COMPUTER EDUCATION TECHNIQUES, INC.

Under Section 1304 of the Business Corporation Law

COMPUTER EDUCATION TECHNIQUES, INC., a foreign corporation desiring to do business in the State of New York pursuant to the provisions of Section 1304 of the Business Corporation Law, HEREBY CERTIFIES:

FIRST: That the name of the Corporation is "COMPUTER EDUCATION TECHNIQUES, INC."

SECOND: That it was incorporated under the laws of the State of Delaware on May 28, 1982.

THIRD: That the business it proposes to do in to do in this State, which it is also authorized to do in the jurisdiction of its incorporation is:

"To engage in the business of developing, conducting, supplying and furnishing seminars, instruction courses, instruction materials and other learning assistance for specialized personnel, including, but not limited to, computer programmers, computer operators, and computer analysts, to any person, to any and all kinds of business organizations and governmental agencies. To purchase, lease and otherwise acquire computers, computer time and sites

for the conducting of its instruction courses and seminars. To advise and counsel businesses, firms and individuals concerning seminars, instruction courses and instruction materials to be developed and implemented on an individual or group basis.

Nothing herein shall authorize the Corporation to operate or maintain any institute of higher learning or to grant degrees."

FOURTH: That the office of the Corporation within the State of New York is to be located in the City and County of New York.

FIFTH: That the Secretary of State of New York is hereby designated as the agent of the Corporation upon whom process against it may be served; and the post office address to which the Secretary of State shall mail a copy of any process against it served upon him is do Richard H. Rosenblum, Esq., 217 Broadway, New York, New York 10007.

SIXTH: That the Corporation has not since its incorporation engaged in any activity in this State, except as set forth in paragraph (b) of Section 1301 of the Business Corporation Law.

SEVENTH: That attached hereto is a certificate by an authorized officer of the jurisdiction of its incorporation that the Corporation is an existing corporation.
